

## Korean Dream Framework: Building a Free and Unified Korea as a Catalyst for Regional and Global Transformation

The forum conveners have been consistently building international support for a Free and Unified Korea as an urgent priority not a distant goal. Such a Korea will be nuclear-free and uphold freedom, democratic values, rule of law and human rights, based on the shared identity and cultural heritage of the Korean people. The Korean Dream approach, predicated on the ideals embodied in the ancient Korean ethos of *Hongik Ingan* (living for the greater benefit of all humanity,) can serve as a guiding framework for building this new nation which can be a catalyst for regional and global peace and development.

Today the world faces many uncertainties and new challenges, such as intensifying US-China relations, the unprecedented global pandemic, unpredictable and destabilizing behavior by DPRK, as well as polarizing political divisions and changing leadership dynamics in the US, ROK and many key nations. These circumstances will likely have far-reaching social, economic, and geopolitical consequences impacting the global order. Given this con-text, moral and innovative leadership is urgently needed to advance the agenda of a Free and Unified Korea.
