Project Goal: Increase local community awareness and understanding of the risk factors for radicalization to violence and threat of targeted violence and terrorism in Prince George's County, Maryland.

Project Objectives:

1. Community and faith leaders are aware of the threat, radicalization process, and associated risk factors and have developed an increased level of commitment to preventing targeted violence and terrorism in their communities.
2. Community and faith leaders are able to act on their awareness training by developing the capacity to provide awareness raisings for their own peers and constituents.
3. Global Peace Foundation is able to assess the impact of awareness trainings and programming on participant knowledge.

Project Activities:

1. Community Partner Briefings: Conduct 4 community partner briefings to introduce project goal and objectives, build case for support, educate and ensure that the target audiences are aware of the threat to, and vulnerability of youth.
2. Awareness Raising Trainings: Deliver 6 in-person and 14 virtual training sessions for community and faith leaders to enhance their understanding of threat of targeted violence and terrorism and enrich their ability to recognize risk factors of radicalization to violence.
3. Social Media Campaign: Initiate a social media campaign, consisting of 104 social media posts on Facebook, twitter and YouTube reaching 10,000 people to raise awareness about the prevalence and risk factors of radicalization and mobilization to targeted violence and terrorism in Maryland.
